A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family,

I would like to take this opportunity to express my sincere thanks to all who helped to make our Holy Week and Easter liturgies so beautiful. The Church was decorated beautifully by our Art and Environment committee. Our musicians, cantors and choir members led us beautifully in song. Our liturgical ministers (i.e. E.M.'s, Lectors, Altar Servers and Deacons) gave generously of their time and talent. God was truly praised as we celebrated the events that led to our Redemption by our Lord Jesus Christ. My thanks to all!

This Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. This feast was established by Pope St. John Paul II and derives its importance from the revelations of our Lord to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska of the Blessed Sacrament. On February 22, 1931, Faustina was visited by Jesus, who presented himself as the "King of Divine Mercy" wearing a white garment with red and pale rays coming from his heart. She was asked to become the apostle and secretary of God's mercy, a model of how to be merciful to others, and an instrument for reemphasizing God's plan of mercy for the world.

On October 5, 1938, Faustina passed away. She was buried on October 7 and currently rests at the Basilica of Divine Mercy in Krakow, Poland. St. Faustina Kowalska was beatified on April 18, 1993 and canonized on April 30, 2000, both by Pope St. John Paul II. Her feast day is celebrated on October 5 and she is the patron saint of Mercy.
